

WISE MAN AND FOOLISH MAN OBJECT LESSON

Matthew 6-7

At the end of Matthew 7, we are taught the wise man and foolish man parable by the Savior. Those who build their foundation upon a rock will survive the rains and floods. But those who build their foundation upon sand will wash away when the rains and floods come. Here's a fun activity for kids to help them understand this parable:

Materials: cookie sheet, rock, sand (dirt or flour also work), small figures (Little Tikes, quarters, etc), water

- 1. Read the story of the wise man and the foolish man in Matthew 7:24-29 as a family.
- 2. Place the rock and a little mound of sand in the cookie sheet. Then place one small figure (or quarter) on the rock and put another on the mound of sand.
- 3. Explain that you're going to do an experiment to see exactly what happens when the rain comes down on these two foundations.
- 4. Have one of the kids slowly pour water on the rock. Discuss what happened.
- 5. Have another kid slowly pour water on the sand. Discuss what happened this time.
- 6. Talk about what we can do to make sure our foundations are like rocks.
