## PAUL'S EPISTLES MATCHING GAME

**Materials Needed:** One set of Paul's Epistles Matching Cards, Copies of the New Testament

**Instructions:**

1. Print off cards on cardstock and cut out on the dotted lines (see following pages for printables).
2. Play matching game a variety of ways:
  - a. Lay cards face up and have everyone help match the verse to the scripture reference by looking up words in the New Testament
  - b. Divide into teams and play as above, but as soon as a team finds a match, they get to keep the set. The team with the most sets wins.
  - c. Once your family has learned which verses/scripture references go together, play a traditional memory game by placing all of the cards face down on a table and take turns drawing pairs until all the cards have been matched.
